Connecting Conservative Anabaptist Business Leaders

Several years ago, Matt Byler talked about the power of mastermind groups (business networks) on a podcast. Men he admired who changed history were all part of mastermind groups – including Thomas Jefferson, Henry Ford, and Harvey Firestone. By meeting and interacting with other likeminded men, they accomplished more than they ever could have on their own.

While people like Ford and Firestone were concerned about business success, we are concerned about the personal growth of the business leader.

After the podcast, Matt received phone calls from conservative Anabaptist businessmen who said, “Hey if you ever start a group, I’d like to be part of it.” They were business leaders tired of feeling alone, tired of feeling overwhelmed and stagnant, and tired of not having anyone to talk with about business challenges.

They began to meet, and although it was worthwhile from the start, it became

much more meaningful as they got to know each other better. Others heard about their networking group and wanted to join but they hesitated to add new members since the success of the group is influenced by the small size. However, they wanted others to experience the same benefits of belonging to a networking group like theirs.

That’s when they decided to build a framework under which others could start their own small networking groups. This became Symbiz Network.

Since then, more than 60 networking groups have started. This includes Old Order Amish, Old Order Mennonites, Brethren, Mennonites, and other conservative Anabaptist fellowships.
